Nanso Satomi Hakkenden

Also known as the chronicle of the eight dogs. A puppet show originated in Awa from Sengaku period about 800 years ago. The story depicted the overflowing romance of the heroine, Boso Satomi.

Knife Ceremony

A very rare ceremony performed at Takabe Shrine in Boso Peninsula. It is a solemn ceremony that passed on tradition of Japanese cuisine that allows audience to observe skilled knife handling based on ancient rites where offering is cut efficiently without touching a hand to keep the pureness since its for the Gods.

Urayasu Musical Accompaniment

A group of performers who uses different Japanese traditional musical instruments in their theatrical dance, lion dance, and more performances.







Tokyo 2020 Postponed to 2021

The International Committee, International Paralympic Committee, Tokyo 2020 Organizing Committee, Tokyo Government, and Japan agreed that the Olympic and Paralympic Games be rescheduled to 2021 amidst the COVID-19 pandemic. Originally scheduled to take place between July 24 and August 9, 2020, the Olympic Games will be held from July 23 to August 8, 2021 and Paralympic Games between August 24 and September 5, 2021, - one year away from the original schedule. The XXXII Olympic will be keeping the name 'Tokyo 2020'.

'Chibanian', is the name of an era



Above is the stratum section that has been recognized as important reference in the study of geological period boundary officially recognized as 'Chibanian' era.

The International Union of Geological Sciences has formally adopted 'Chibanian' as the name of a geological era. The announcement was held during the executive meeting held in Busan, South Korea on Jan. 17, 2020. The naming is for the stratum section found in Chiba Prefecture which shows evidence of the most recent reversal of earth's magnetic field which plays a vital reference point for studying the geological period boundary believed to be 774,000 years old. Chibanian Age is the first time Japan has been presented in a geological age.

Ichihara City where the stratum is located welcomed the news with confidence and anticipate with any positive effects the recognition to bring in the growth of the local economy.

Chiba Business Event Destination Seminar in India







The number of incentive tour travelers from India to Japan has increased rapidly in recent years. However, Chiba remains unpopular destination to many of the citizens, and in which somehow known as 'somewhere close to Tokyo or Narita Airport. In order to enhance knowledge to the wider Indian market about the prefecture, Chiba Convention Bureau held the 'Business Event Destination Seminar in India', first time in India on February 20, 2020. The event is in cooperation with the Japan National Tourism Organization (JNTO) New Delhi Office. The event has successfully attracted 20 representatives from various travel agencies in the New Delhi metropolitan area.

The seminar that was mainly focused on the infrastructural capabilities of Chiba as business event destination has showcased introduction of various facilities such as Makuhari Messe and Kazusa Akademia. It also included presentation of Chiba's natural resources such as cherry blossoms with Chiba Castle at the background, a stunning view of a trolley train passing through a beautiful rape blossoms field, the magnificent beach and emerald ocean, and the extravagant view of the autumn leaves of Yoro Valley were just some that truly impressed the audience.

With its growing trend of manufacturing industry in Japan, CCB expects more incentive groups coming to Chiba.

An old neighborhood called 'Hasuike'





In the heart of Chiba Prefecture's capital Chiba City situated an old district known as 'Hasuike'. Literally means 'lotus pond', this area was once an oasis for Samurais and merchants who are seeking place to relax and unwind.

Hasuike was most popular some more than hundred years ago from Taisho to Showa Era and was known as the 'district of Geisha'. Back then, people from the neighboring towns came all the way to Hasuike with their horses and carriages for food, drinks, and entertainment. Japanese women known as geisha which translate specifically as "woman art" entertained visitors through performance of ancient traditions of art, dance and music. As the economy prosper, Hasuike became the epicenter of economy where major transportation and establishments were built.





As the grow continued and the area were expanded reaching up to the ocean which resulted to the development and reclamation of a new district. To bring people closer to the new site, the city office has been relocated and the major train station has been transferred leaving less people in the old district.

At present, nestled behind the busy street where high rise buildings and modern establishments is an old settling of samurai Japan of few shops of over hundred years old stood. Yet the name 'Hasuike' is now unfamiliar, this once a red-light district remained in the heart of each villager, and the story which for them seems just yesterday continued to be told today and up to the generations to come.

Around Hasuike district are unique venues for business events namely Chiba City Museum of Arts, Folk Museum, and more that include shops that are uniquely Chiba.
