Location Map



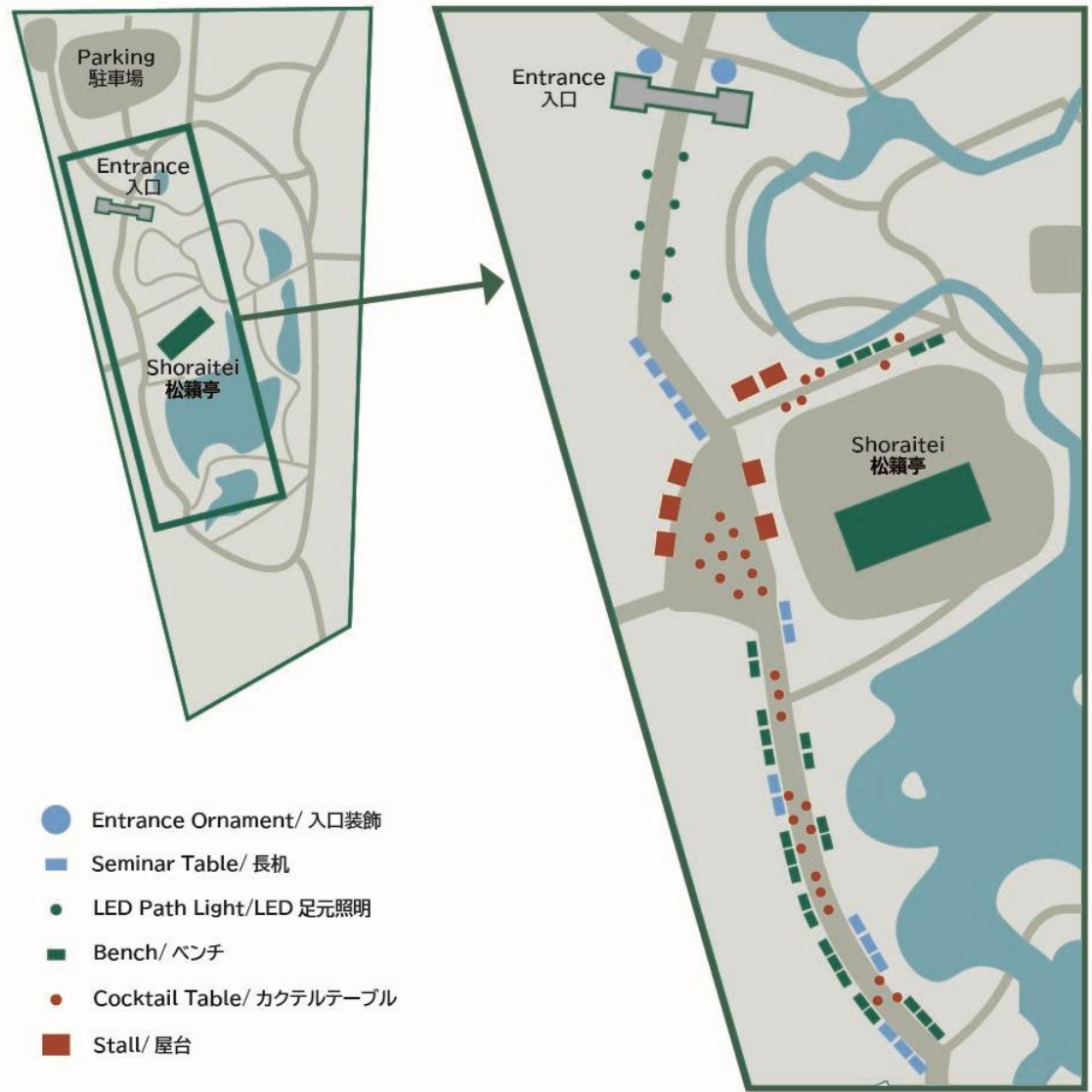

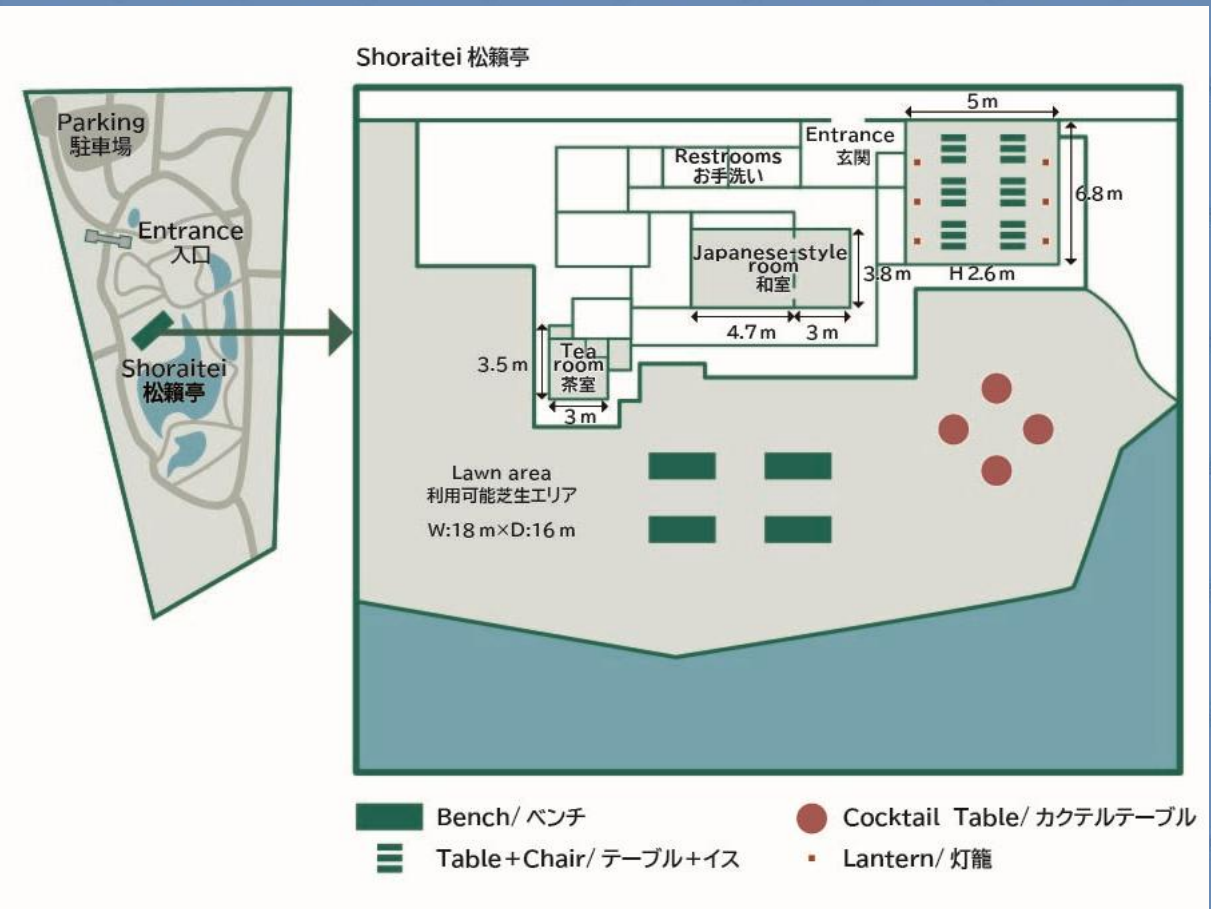

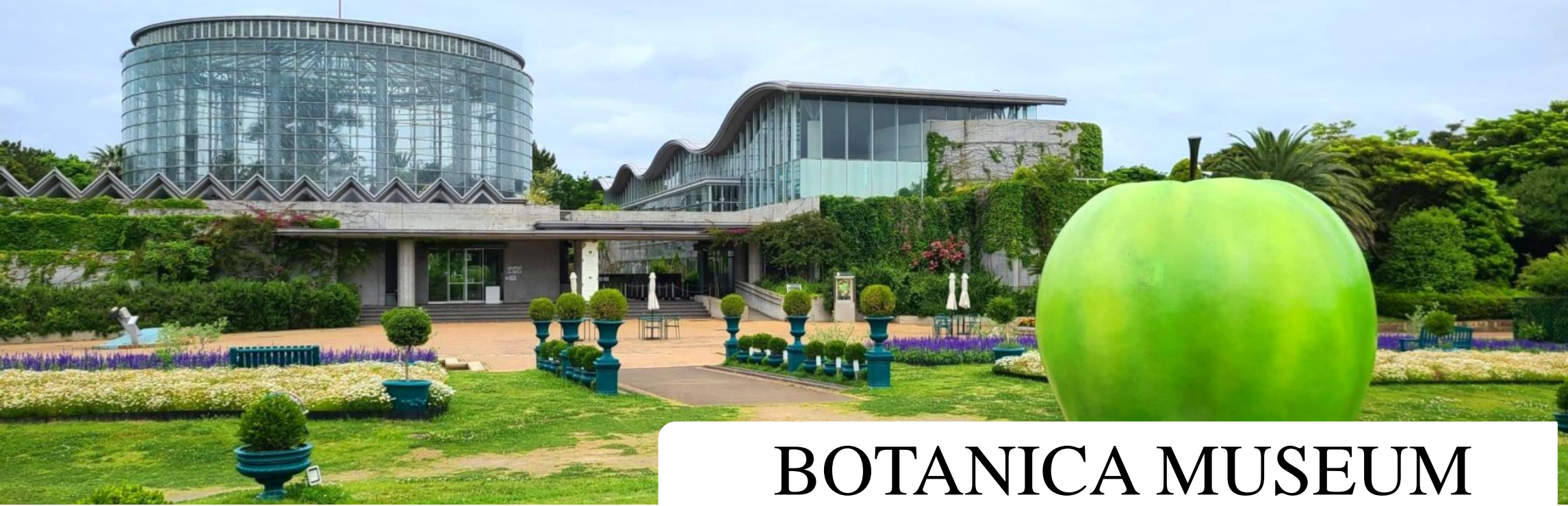

BOTANICA MUSEUM

Experience the Miracle of Nature

Founded in 1995 and newly reopened in 2025, the BOTANICA MUSEUM is home to over 48,000 plants and 1,600 species. The museum is divided into five main areas: Atrium, Greenhouse, Garden, Workshop and Restaurant. The museum is designed to engage all five senses to fully experience the appeal of nature:

Sight: Objects sprouting from the seeds of sensibility transform sight into emotion.

Hearing: The sounds of nature resonate throughout the museum, transforming hearing into mind and body.

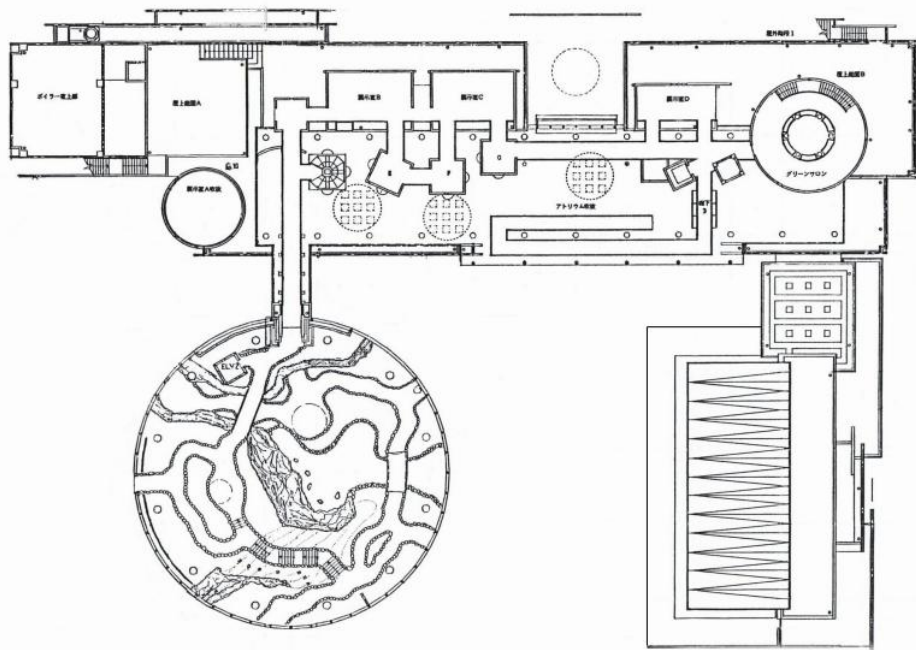
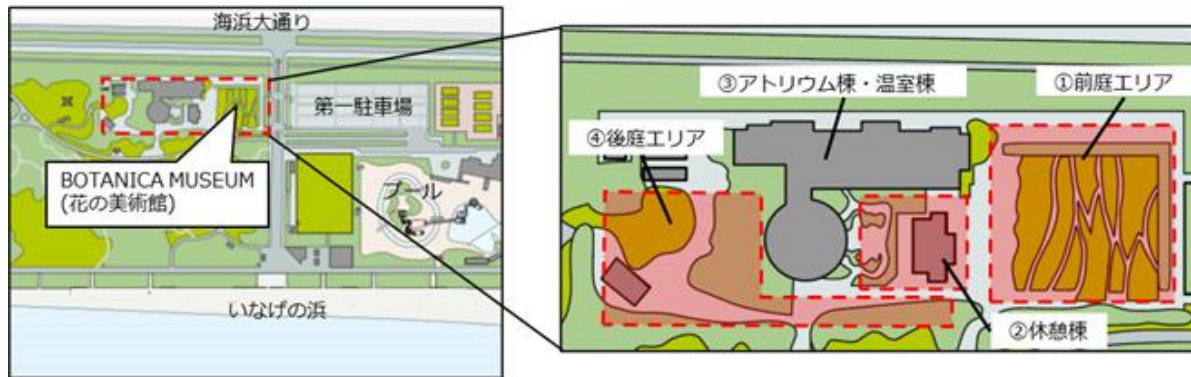
Smell: Objects that emphasize scent evoke "memories," transforming smell into memory.

Touch: Touching plants, miracles of nature, transforms touch into essence.

Taste: A restaurant integrated with nature transforms taste into abundance.

The museum was produced by Hikaru Seino, a leading floral artist active around the world. He also founded GANON FLORIST in 2013 and has been invited to give lectures as a maestro at fashion shows overseas and at a Gaudi architecture exhibition in Spain.

The restaurant offers dishes using edible flowers, allowing guests to enjoy seasonal plants in the courtyard, making the museum an ideal location for special occasions, such as parties.

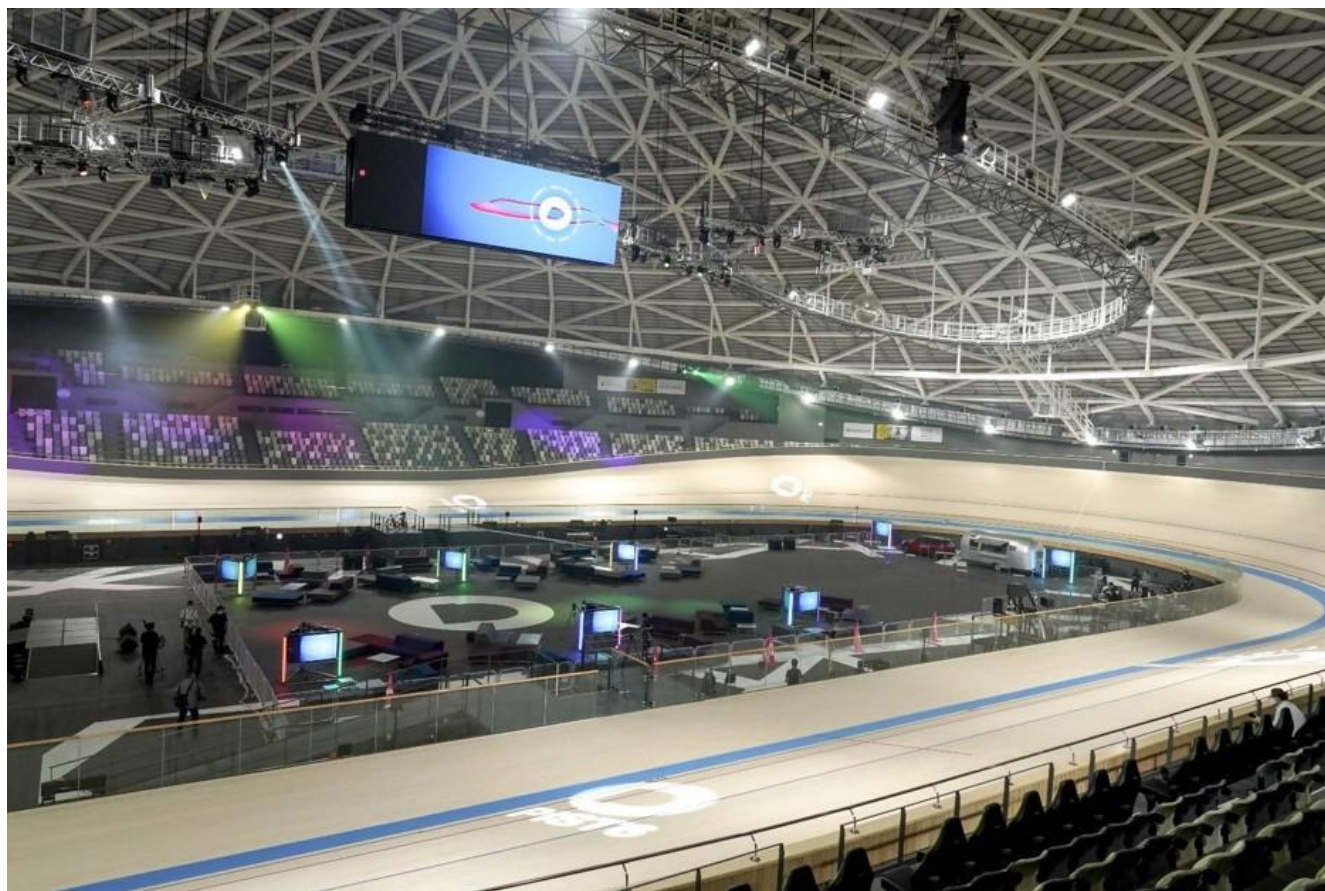
CHIBA JPF DOME

CHIBA JPF DOME was completed in October 2021 at the site of the Chiba Bicycle Racetrack is a world-class velodrome with a 250-meter wooden bank.

Facilities include arena seats, VIP rooms, a bar, and three food areas. This venue allows unique stage settings that utilize cutting-edge audio and lighting equipment, next-generation visual equipment and laser lighting, making it suitable not only for bicycle races but also for other sporting events, music events and MICE events.

Chiba City Museum of Art

The interior of this unique museum preserves the original neo-Renaissance-style when it was first built as a bank before World War II.

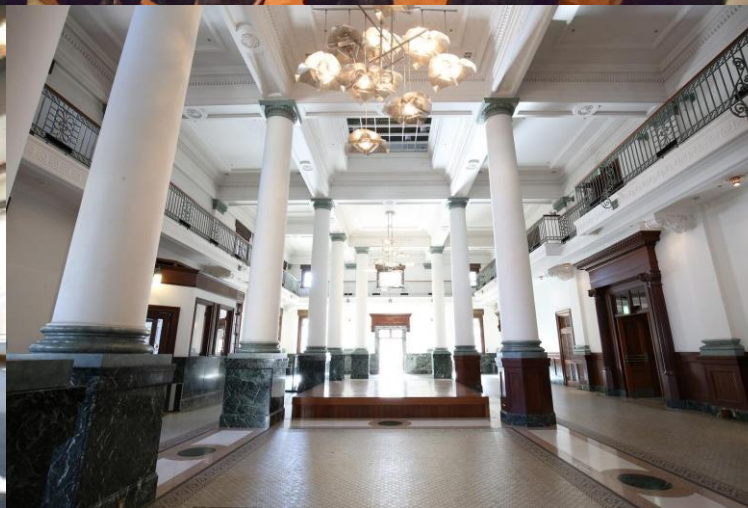
Following expansion work, the museum reopened on July 11th 2020 with additional facilities to attract a broader range of age groups, as well as existing galleries used for planned exhibitions.

Guests can enjoy a permanent exhibition that showcases highlights of a collection of around 10,000 artworks, including Ukiyo-e, modern and contemporary Japanese paintings, prints, contemporary art and pieces related to the Bōsō region, as well as interactive projects where visitors can participate alongside artists.

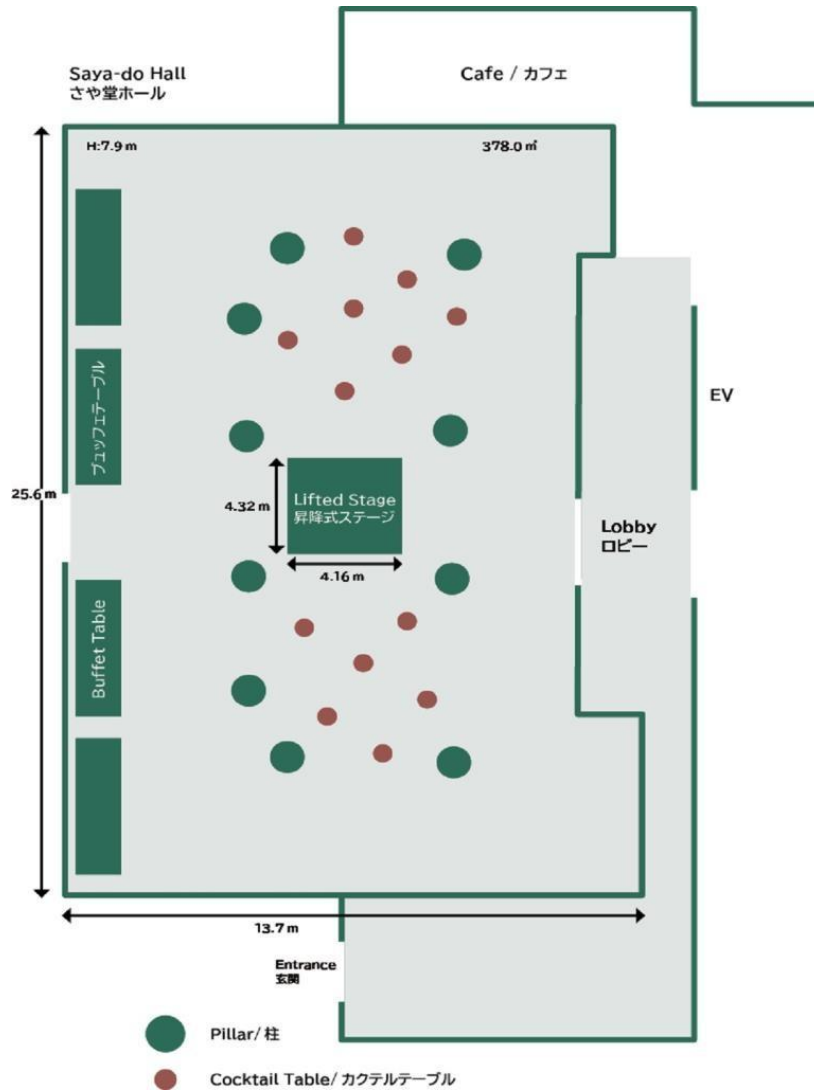
There are also workshop rooms and a glass-walled auditorium, which can be used for a variety of purposes.

Chiba City Folk Museum (Chiba Castle)

The Chiba City Folk Museum (Chiba Castle) was built by the Chiba Clan during the Warring States Period on the site of Inohana Castle. It is now known as “Chiba Castle” by citizens.

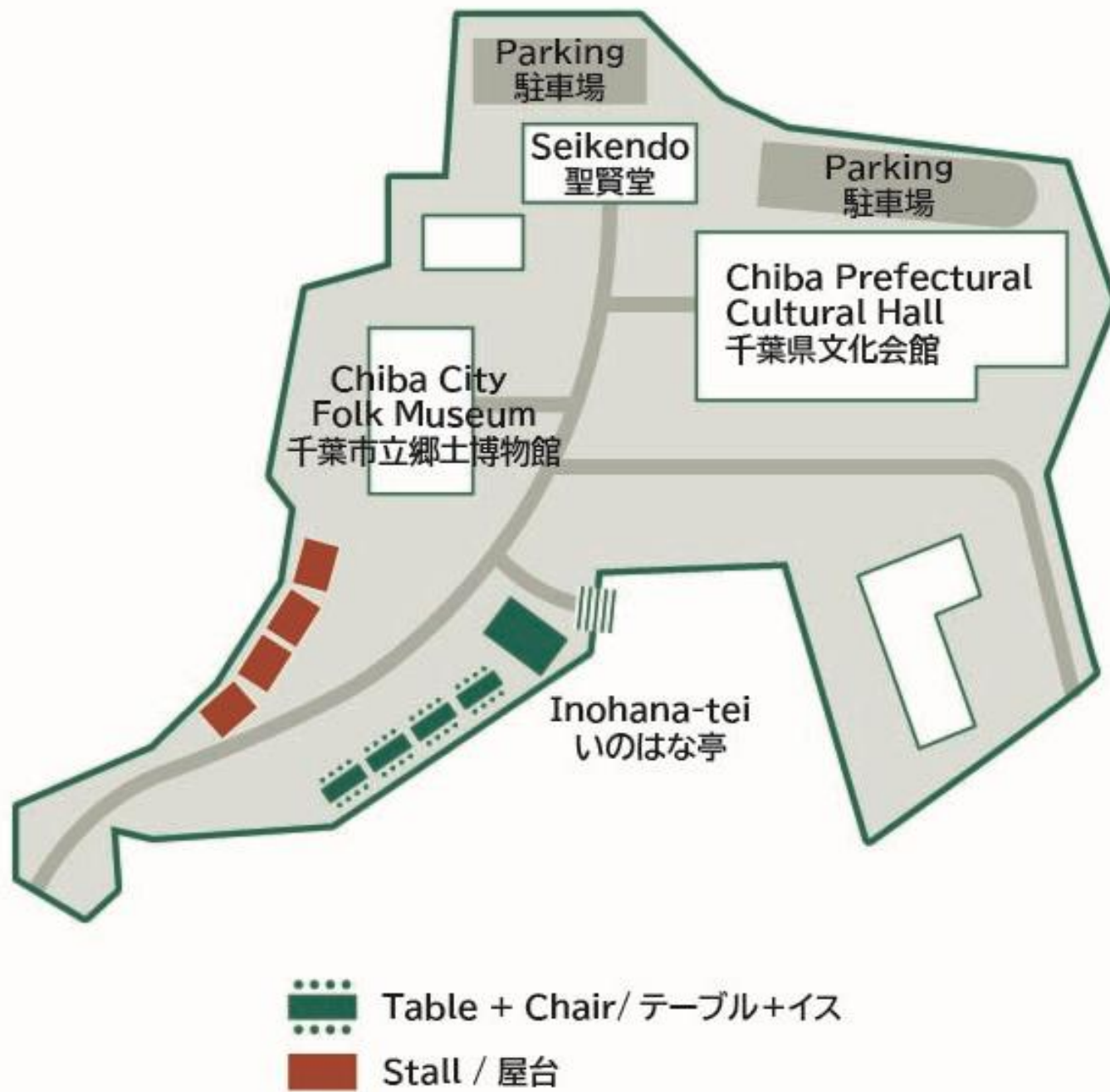
Views of downtown Chiba City and the port area can be enjoyed from the observation area on the 5th floor and visitors can learn about the history of Chiba City on the other floors.

The castle is located in Inohana Park, which is famous for cherry blossoms and also has a traditional Japanese tearoom. Every spring, an annual cherry blossom festival takes place in the park.

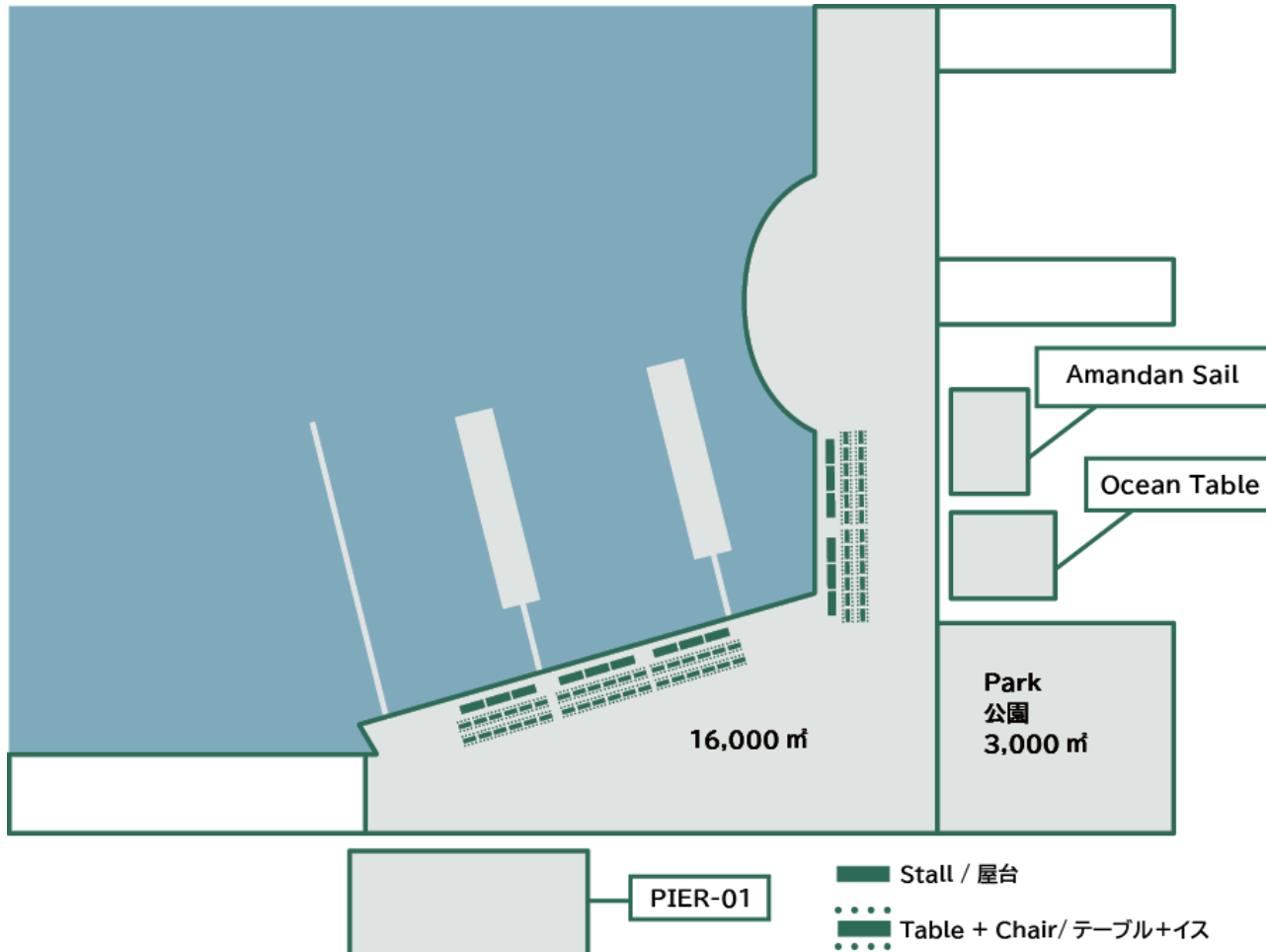
Chibaminato port and pier (Chiba Central Port's passenger ship pier) has been developed together with the K's Harbor (a ferry passenger terminal) commercial facility as part of Chiba Port Park, where visitors can enjoy a natural environment beside the sea.

Guests can use three facilities (PIER-01, Ocean Table and Amandan Sail) near the port and the green space in front of the pier in an integrated manner to hold various types of large-scale outdoor events and parties.

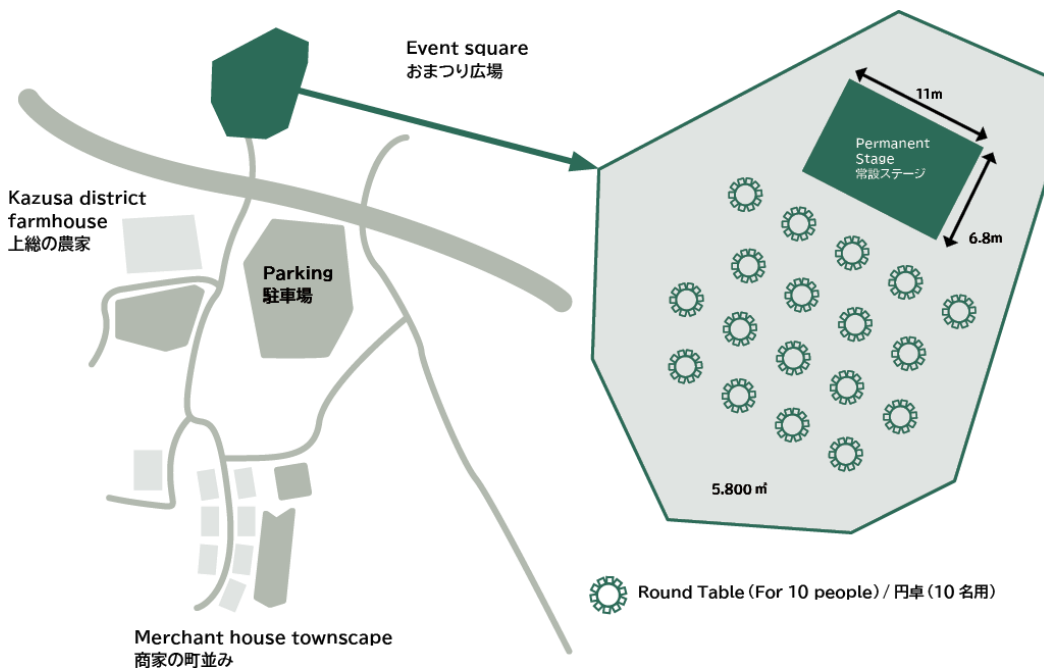
Open-Air Museum Bōsō-no-Mura

This history museum aims to allow visitors to experience traditional lifestyles and crafts native to the Bōsō region and learn about history through the exhibition of archaeological antiquities from across the prefecture in recreated houses of samurai, merchants, farmers, as well as through interactive workshops and experiences.

Visit Bōsō-no-Mura to deepen your understanding of traditional culture using all five senses. A unique venue, visitors can step into the past and enjoy the village streets and a traditional town square of Bōsō in a rich natural environment near Narita Airport.

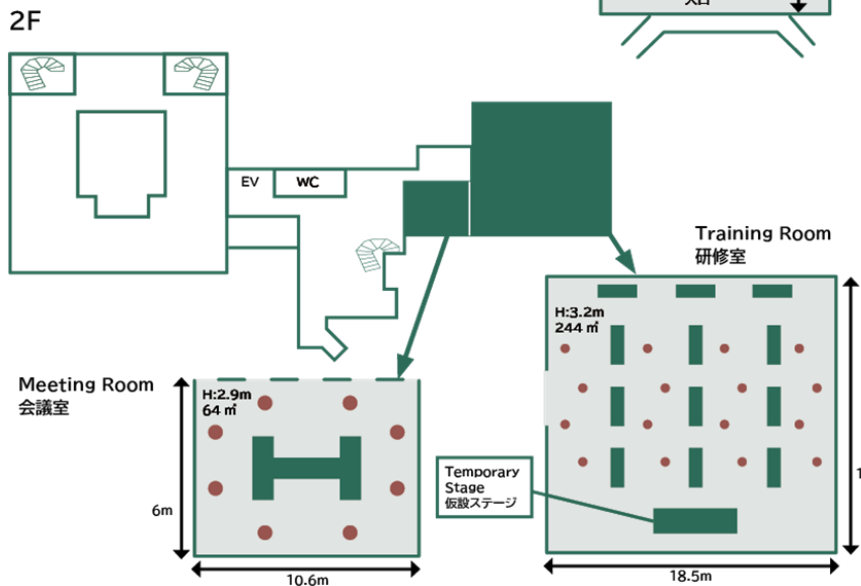
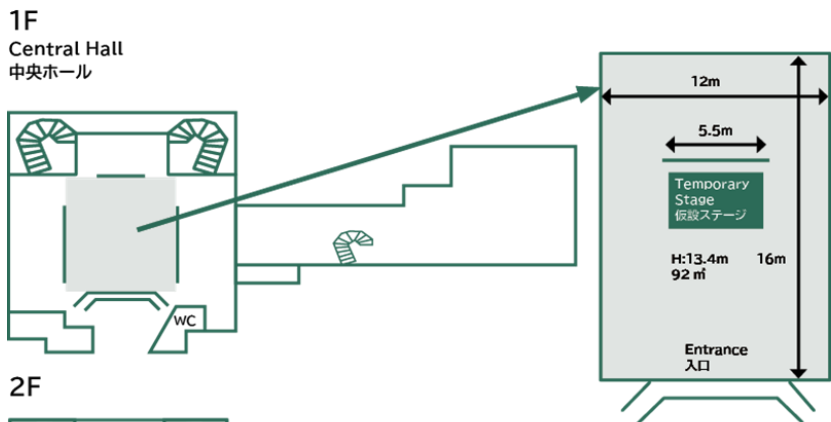


Naritasan Museum of Calligraphy

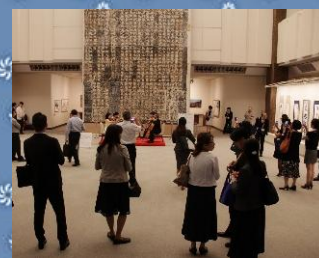
The Naritasan Museum of Calligraphy is a comprehensive museum dedicated to calligraphy that holds around seven rotating exhibitions each year. Opened in 1992, the museum's collection of 6,000 items ranges from delicate old writings and early sutra copies dating back to the Heian and Nara Periods, to large and dynamic contemporary calligraphic works. The museum plans exhibitions on a wide range of different themes to share the appeal of calligraphy. Visitors to the museum can expect to find something new every time they go.

Naritasan Park is located directly behind the museum, spanning an impressive 160,000 square metres. Within the park, visitors can enjoy the seasonal scenery, including stone monuments to famous Japanese literary figures, as well as plum blossoms, cherry blossoms, wisteria, chrysanthemums and autumn leaves. The floating temple (Ukimido), the suikinkutsu (water harp cave) and the "Fudedama" (brush spirit) monument are also popular attractions.

With its massive exterior and spacious, high-ceilinged interior, the museum was built to a temple-inspired design. Upon entering the museum building, your eyes are immediately caught by a 13-meter-high ink impression called "Rubbing of the Stone Stele's Inscription of Taishan", which is exhibited in the 20-metre high Central Hall. The scale of the work, which was reportedly written by Emperor Xuanzong of the Tang Dynasty, is something to experience.

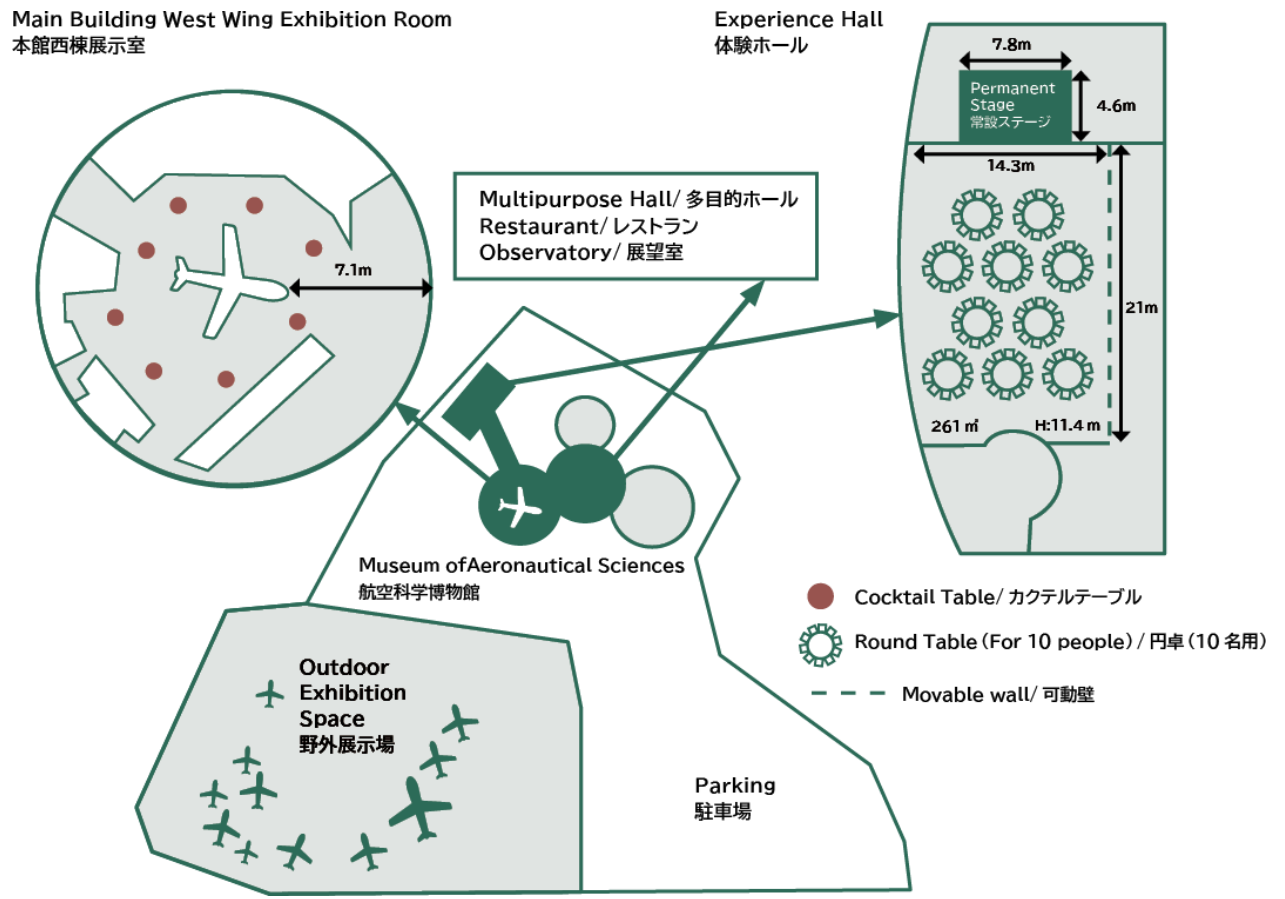

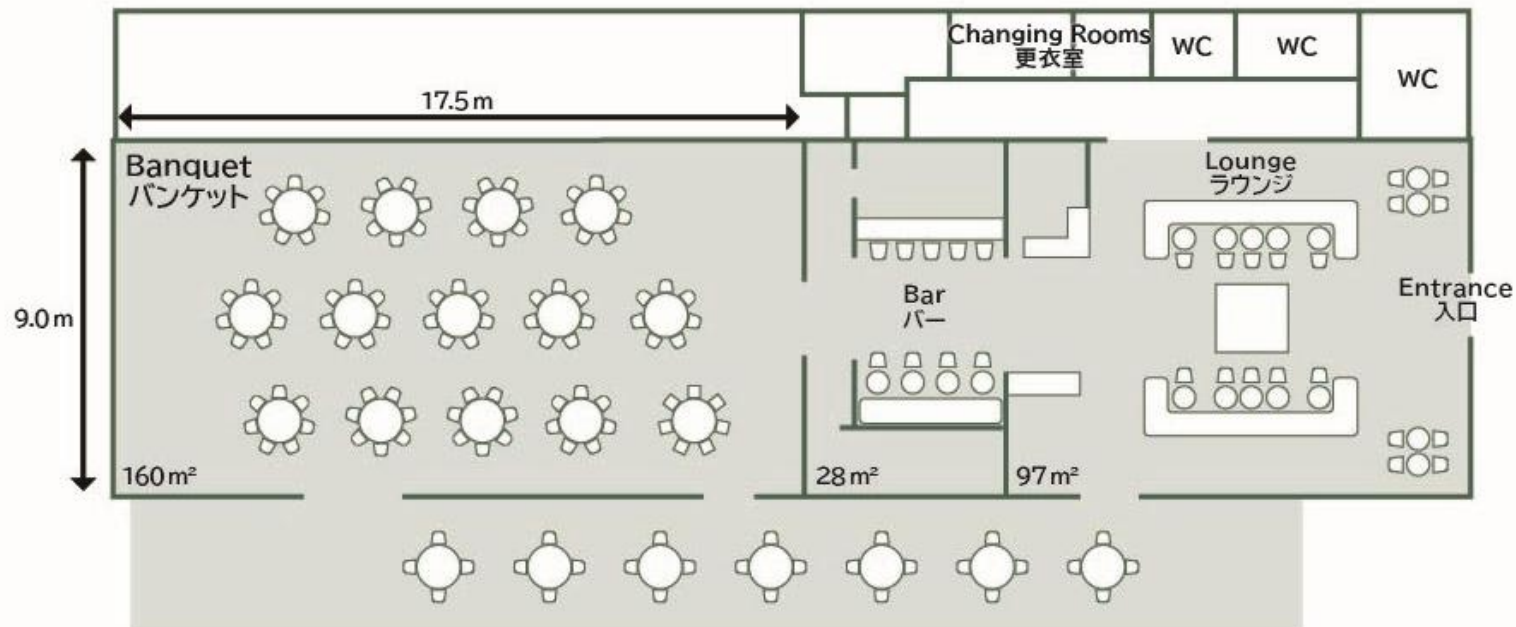
NIPPONIA KAGURA

The area developed around food and brewing culture, producing sake, miso and soy sauce using high-quality local rice, with a long-standing focus on fermentation and regional ingredients. Guests can enjoy dishes made with locally sourced ingredients unique to this area—featuring fermented foods such as sake lees—paired with sake delivered directly from nearby breweries.

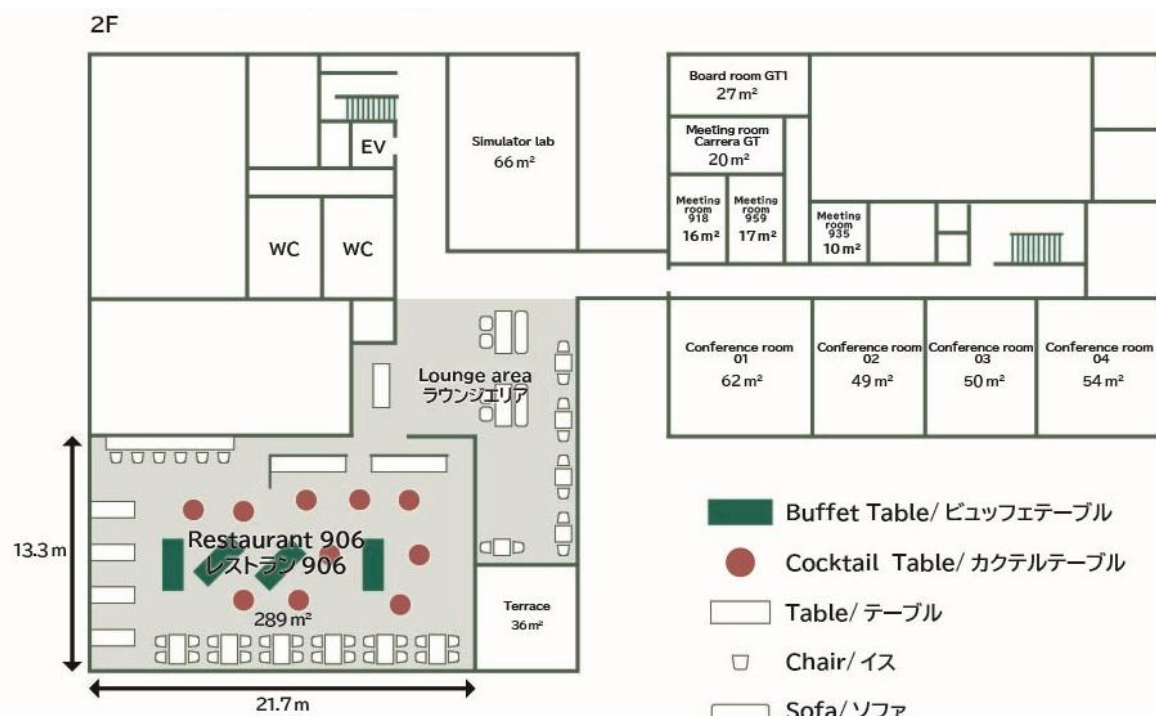
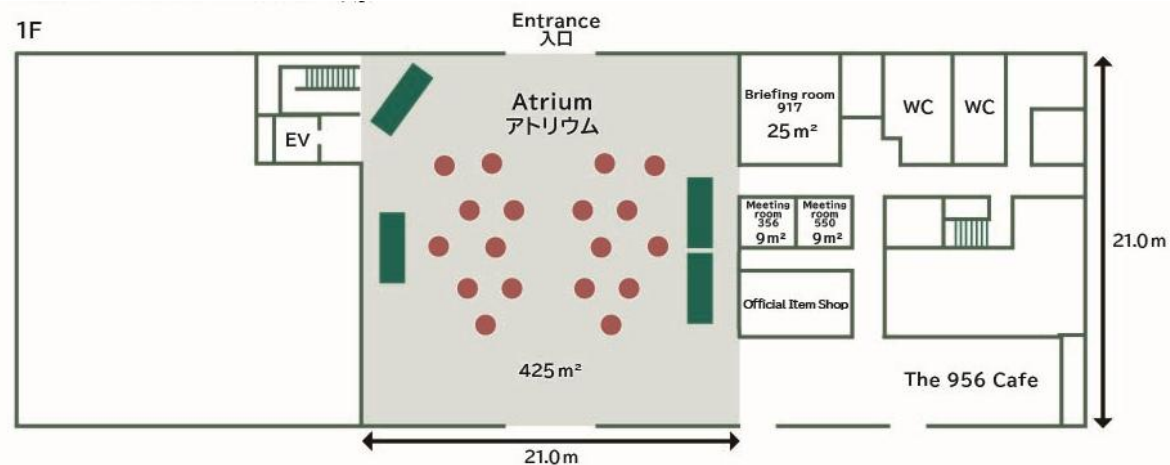
Porsche Experience Center Tokyo
