

## About 1,300 researchers to gather at Makuhari Messe Chiba to host the 2025 Photonics and Electromagnetics Research Symposium (PIERS 2025)

The Chiba International Convention Bureau (CCB), an affiliated organization of Chiba Prefecture aimed to promote Chiba as business event destination is dedicated in strengthening the prefectural's position in the global market and help improve the academic and tourism industry in order to attract gatherings including those with high global economic growth prospects such as international conferences.
